## Summary

Used to declaratively specify permission to request information from Domain Name Servers.

## Description

[*Note:* The security information declared by a security attribute is stored in the metadata of the attribute target, and is accessed by the system at run-time. Security attributes are used for declarative security only. For imperative security, use the corresponding permission class, `System.Net.DnsPermission`.

The allowable `System.Net.DnsPermissionAttribute` targets are determined by the `System.Security.Permissions.SecurityAction` passed to the constructor.

## Summary

Constructs a new instance of the `System.Net.DnsPermissionAttribute` class with the specified `System.Security.Permissions.SecurityAction` value.

## Parameters

## Exceptions

Exception	Condition

## Summary

Returns a `System.Net.DnsPermission` instance that contains the security information of the current instance.

## Return Value

A `System.Net.DnsPermission` object with the security information of the current instance.

## Description

[*Note:* Applications typically do not call this method; it is intended for use by the system.

The security information described by a security attribute is stored in the metadata of the attribute target, and is accessed by the system at run-time. The system uses the object returned by this method to convert the security information of the current instance into the form stored in metadata.

This method overrides  
`System.Security.Permissions.SecurityAttribute.CreatePermission.`
