### **Foreword**

This Guide was drawn up by the ISO Committee on conformity assessment, ISO/CASCO. It was approved by the ISO Council in September 1986 and by the IEC Council in October 1986.

# Guidelines for third-party assessment and registration of a supplier's Quality System

#### 0 Introduction

- **0.1** These guidelines are valid for a third-party system of assessing and registering a supplier's Quality System, wherein:
  - this third-party system is designed primarily for use on an industry sector basis or by individual companies, and is related to the products, processes or services being supplied;
  - the supplier is capable of providing such quality assurance as specified in the relevant Quality System Standard (e.g. ISO 9001, ISO 9002 or ISO 9003) together with supplementary documentation as required.
- **0.2** The objective of this third-party system is to provide, by means of assessment and subsequent surveillance, an adequate level of confidence that the supplier's Quality System conforms to the identified requirements for that system.
- 0.3 This third-party system involves only the assessment of the supplier's Quality System and is not concerned with the certification of products, processes or services.
- **0.4** The identification of conformance to the appropriate Quality System Standard and any supplementary documentation will be in the form of a registration document.
- **0.5** A body operating the system shall conform to the applicable requirements of ISO/IEC Guide 40.

#### 1 Scope and field of application

This guide sets forth criteria, the observance of which is intended to ensure that assessment bodies operate third-party assessment systems in a consistent and reliable manner, thereby facilitating their acceptance and recognition on a national or international basis.

While this document has been produced with a view to providing a basis for harmonizing third-party assessment systems, many of the provisions contained herein might be useful in second-party assessment procedures.
